3. These are the petitions filed by the persons whose parents are of Tibetan origin. The petitioners were born in India and claim to be citizens of India by birth. They are, undoubtedly, entitled to a passport subject to compliance of the necessary compliances.

directing that the applications of such citizens be processed. However, such persons are constrained to repeatedly move to this Court.


5. The present petitions indicate yet another impediment that has been placed by the respondents by not cancelling the Identity Certificate/Registration Certificate issued to the petitioners. The petitioners have been running from pillar to post but none of the authorities are accepting the surrender of the said certificates and, on the other hand, the passport facilities have been rejected on the ground that the petitioners have not surrendered their respective Identity cards/ Registration certificates.

6. Mr Gogna, learned counsel appearing for the respondents assures this Court that within a period of three working days, the entire process would be streamlined and shall be put on the website so that such citizens are not constrained to repeatedly approach this Court.
